As the global impact of COVID-19 has affected manufacturing, altered supply and demand predictability, and created unfore-seen gaps with suppliers, manufacturers are responding by paying increasing attention to the resilience of their supply chain. So much so, that "resilience" as a concept has grown from a little-used term into an oft-cited core tenet of the intelligent supply chain. In this session, we will discuss key drivers for a resilient supply chain, as well as provide examples of how organizations world over are rethinking the supply chain as they navigate the new normal.

Dr. A. "Ravi" Ravindran recently retired from Penn State University USA. He has been a Professor of Industrial and Manufacturing Engineering and also the Chair of Enterprise Integration Consortium at the University. Formerly, he was a Professor of Industrial Engineering at the University of Oklahoma and at Purdue University. He has authored six books and won numerous Best Teacher Awards in his career spanning five decades.

He has been associated with IIMM for its Supply Chain Management events like SCALE, NATCOM from year 2000 and has conducted advanced workshops. He has guided more than 30 graduate students through their Ph.D. programs as the Principal Guide.

Students of Professor Ravindran came together and organized a symposium in his honour in 2015 at Bangalore. This Endowment Lecture series has emanated from the above symposium.
